 "The famous McCrea Cuvee Orleans came from this vineyard, and the 2022 Syrah Motor City Kitty continues the site's reputation for greatness, offering a ripe style and lots of wood, but showing something very special in its spicy, meaty, herbal complexion, memorable particularly for its sense of purity and balance. Made in a dense, brooding, full-bodied style, it spent time fermenting in concrete tank on its skins for 45 days before settling into 500-liter puncheon for 15 months on the lees. Dark fruit and spicy dried herbs accent the core of the wine, which will benefit from further aging, 10-12 years."

Oregon - Chardonnay  
*Boedecker Willamette Valley Chardonnay*  
2023

Boedecker Cellars focuses on small-lot Oregon wines with a balance of Old World restraint and New World fruit. Their Chardonnay often uses neutral oak and lees aging. Apple, citrus, and light creaminess—pair with roast chicken, seafood, or pasta.

*Phelps Creek Columbia Gorge Gewurztraminer*

Phelps Creek is a boutique, family-owned estate based in Hood River, sourcing this fruit from the

Gorge Crest vineyard on Underwood Mountain, where a sunny south-facing slope and strong Gorge winds create ideal conditions for aromatic whites. The winery uses extended skin contact during pressing to build texture and complexity while preserving the grape's natural floral intensity. Lychee, rose petal, citrus zest, and spiced orchard fruit with bright acidity—perfect with spicy Asian cuisine, pork dishes, or soft cheeses.



Oregon - Pinot Noir  
*Evesham Wood Willamette Valley Pinot Noir*  
2024

"Taut and focused, this wine amplifies the purity of fruit and the precision of the Eola-Amity Hills. Comprised of fruit from five Eola Amity sites, including those with tremendous reputations like Koosah, Sojeau and the estate Le Puits Sec. Pure red and blue fruits on the nose with savoury spice, sea salt and red florals. The palate is a well-poised blend of juicy berries, raspberry leaf, hibiscus tea and a saline minerality that leads to an upright finish."

"The village red 2021 Black Slate Escaladei was produced with Garnacha and 3% Syrah from vines planted in 1978 and 2001 in the village of Scaladei... It has a bright ruby color, very Garnacha, with an herbal and slightly reduced personality but with floral tones and a pretty nose. It has a medium-bodied palate with very fine tannins and a long dry, tasty finish. Pretty elegant."

## RED

Oregon - Blend  
**Division Winery**  
**Ouest Red 2023**

Division Winemaking Company, founded in Oregon, focuses on Loire- and Rhône-inspired wines using organically farmed fruit from cooler Pacific Northwest sites. The Ouest Red is a blend built around Gamay, Cabernet Franc, and other varietals, emphasizing carbonic elements and low-intervention techniques for freshness and lift. Juicy red berries, herbal notes, and light spice with bright acidity—perfect with charcuterie, roast chicken, or casual bistro fare.



Argentina - Malbec  
**Catena Malbec Appellation**  
**Altamira 2023**

From Catena Zapata, a pioneer of high-altitude Argentine viticulture, this wine comes from the Altamira GI in the Uco Valley, known for its limestone-rich soils and cooler climate. The Catena family has spent decades mapping terroir to highlight site expression in Malbec. "This opens with blue fruit that deepens into darker tones yet remains crunchy, with a hint of pepper. The palate is saline, luminous and chiseled, marked by a delicate veil of fruit and refined tension."

France - Pinot Noir

Dopff & Irion is a historic Alsace house credited with pioneering traditional method sparkling wines in the region. This rosé is typically Pinot Noir-based and made in the same method as Champagne. Fresh strawberry, rose petal, and citrus zest—perfect with charcuterie, light appetizers, or brunch fare.

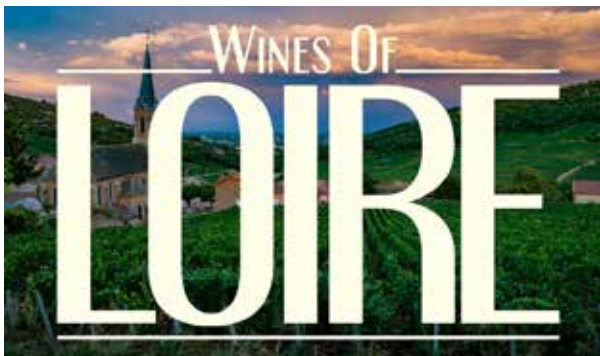
