Rhône. The Création Grosset Cairanne highlights the appellation's stony soils and classic Grenache-led blend. Rich notes of blackberry, plum, garrigue, and pepper pair beautifully with grilled lamb, braised beef, or Provençal cuisine.

"The 2022 Pinot Noir Weber Vineyard comes from vines planted in 1983 and takes a youthful red color with a light haze. More lifted and slightly feral herbal spice lifts from the glass along with notes of fresh red flowers and fresh herbs. It's linear, lifted, and refreshing on the palate and has a pastoral feel, with fine tannins and a note of dewy fresh earth. It's drinking beautifully now and will drink well over the coming 10-12 years. I really love the freshness of this."

Malvira Arneis 2023

Malvirà is one of Piedmont's leading champions of Arneis, cultivating vineyards in the historic Roero region. Their bottling highlights the grape's aromatic character while maintaining freshness and minerality. Pear, white flowers, citrus, and almond notes make it an ideal pairing for seafood, antipasti, and light pasta dishes.

Felsina is one of Tuscany's benchmark estates, renowned for producing traditionally styled Sangiovese from the southern reaches of Chianti Classico. The Riserva spends extended time aging before release, developing added complexity and structure. Layers of black cherry, dried herbs, leather, and spice make it an excellent match for steak Florentine, pasta Bolognese, or aged Pecorino.

Bodegas Borsao is one of Spain's leading producers in Campo de Borja, a region famed for old-vine Garnacha. Cabriola blends Garnacha with international varieties, creating a rich and powerful expression. Dark berry fruit, cocoa, vanilla, and spice complement grilled meats, barbecue, and hearty stews.

Portugal - Alvarinho
Nortico Alvarinho 2024

Nortico sources fruit from Portugal's Vinho Verde region, where Atlantic influences create vibrant and aromatic wines. Made entirely from Alvarinho, it captures the grape's freshness and mineral character. Lime, peach, and saline notes make it a natural partner for shellfish, sushi, and light fish dishes.

Domaine Reverdy-Ducroux is a family-owned estate in Sancerre, farming limestone-rich vineyards that define the region's classic style. Les Caillottes comes from rocky soils that contribute freshness and mineral precision to the wine. Lemon, grapefruit, white flowers, and flinty minerality make it a perfect pairing for goat cheese,

oysters, and fresh seafood.



Washington - Rosé

Walla Walla Vintners has been crafting expressive Washington wines since the 1990s, helping establish the Walla Walla Valley as a premier wine region. Their rosé is made to emphasize freshness, bright fruit, and lively acidity. Flavors of strawberry, watermelon, and citrus make it a perfect companion to grilled seafood, picnic fare, or warm afternoons.

Lucius is designed as a lighter, chillable expression of Mourvèdre that emphasizes freshness over power. Juicy blackberry, wild herbs, and peppery spice make it delicious slightly chilled alongside charcuterie, grilled vegetables, or pizza.



California - Rosé

Hogwash Rosé is produced by Tuck Beckstoffer, a member of Napa Valley's renowned Beckstoffer wine family known for farming some of California's most celebrated vineyards. Crafted in a bright, Provence-inspired style, the wine emphasizes freshness, balance, and easy-drinking



appeal. Delicate flavors of strawberry, watermelon, citrus, and white flowers make it a perfect match for seafood, salads, and sunny afternoons.

WHITE

Oregon - White Blend *Big Salt White 2025* **\$16.99 – save \$8.**

Produced by Ovum Wines in Oregon, Big Salt is a cult favorite white blend inspired by the bright, coastal wines of Europe. The wine combines aromatic varieties into a vibrant, highly drinkable expression designed for freshness and versatility.



Bursting with citrus, stone fruit, sea spray, and floral notes, it shines alongside oysters, ceviche, and summer salads.

France - Chardonnay *Domaine Laurent Chardigny Bourgogne Blanc 2023* **\$17.99 – save \$12.**

Domaine Laurent Chardigny farms sustainably in Burgundy, crafting wines that emphasize purity and regional character. This Bourgogne Blanc delivers classic Chardonnay expression from carefully selected vineyard sites. Crisp apple, citrus, and subtle mineral notes pair wonderfully with roast chicken, shellfish, and creamy cheeses.



France - White Blend *Chateau Briot Bordeaux Blanc 2025* **\$11.99 – save \$10.**

Château Briot is a family-run Bordeaux estate producing traditional wines that highlight the region's classic grape varieties. This white blend emphasizes freshness, balance, and bright fruit character. Citrus, gooseberry, and floral notes pair beautifully with seafood, goat cheese, and fresh summer fare.



RED

France - Red Blend *Château Côtes de Blaignan Medoc Cru Bourgeois 2018* **\$15.99 – save \$6.**

Located in the northern Médoc, Château Côtes de Blaignan has earned Cru Bourgeois status through consistent quality and careful vineyard stewardship. Bottle age has allowed the wine to develop added complexity and refinement. Cassis, cedar, tobacco, and earthy notes pair wonderfully with roast beef, lamb, and aged cheeses.

France - Syrah *Yves Cuilleron Les Vignes d'à Côté Syrah 2024* **\$17.99 – save \$8.**

Yves Cuilleron is one of the Northern Rhône's most respected producers, known for expressive wines that capture the character of Syrah. Les Vignes d'à Côté comes from vineyards just outside prestigious appellation boundaries while maintaining regional authenticity. Blackberry, violet, olive tapenade, and pepper notes make it a superb match for grilled meats and hearty French fare.



California - Petit Sirah *Peirano Petite Sirah Lodi 2021* **\$14.99 – save \$6.**

Peirano Estate has farmed in Lodi for generations, producing wines that showcase the region's warm climate and old-vine heritage. Their Petite Sirah is crafted to emphasize richness, concentration, and bold varietal character. Flavors of blackberry, blueberry, dark chocolate, and spice stand up beautifully to barbecue, smoked meats, and rich stews.
