Rioja – Tempranillo
Marques de Riscal Reserva 2020
\$18.99 - save \$11.

One of Rioja's most historic estates, Marqués de Riscal has produced benchmark wines since 1858, and this Reserva spends extended time in oak barrels to develop both complexity and silky integration of fruit and tannin. Red berries, vanilla, and subtle spice make it an excellent match for lamb, tapas, or mature Manchego cheese.

Oregon – Pinot Noir
Benmar Pinot Noir
"Springbok" 2023

"The 2023 Benmar Springbok Pinot Noir from Yamhill-Carlton in Oregon's Willamette Valley is a chiselled, focused, and deeply layered wine. Medium-bodied in presence, it delivers a tremendous concentration of forest berry fruit laced with fragrant conifer and spearmint notes. A thread of cool, wet slate minerality runs from the aromatics to the finish, giving the wine a vivid sense of place.



There's impressive density and fruit weight here, balanced by firm, taut tannins that gradually resolve through that slate-driven mineral core to reveal a juicier, more open-knit character with air—a wine of structure, clarity, and poise."

New Zealand – Sauvignon Blanc
Dog Point Sauvignon Blanc 2024

Crafted in Marlborough, New Zealand, by the Dog Point team who focus on organic viticulture and minimal intervention, this Sauvignon Blanc expresses the region's maritime influence and stony soils with precision. Grapefruit, passionfruit, and flinty minerality shine through, making it a natural pairing for oysters, fresh salads, or goat cheese.

From La Morra in Piedmont, the Cordero family produces Barolo 'Monfalletto' from meticulously tended Nebbiolo vineyards, emphasizing low yields, extended maceration, and traditional aging in large oak casks. Aromas of cherry, rose, and tar are framed by firm tannins, making it a classic companion to truffle dishes, braised meats, or risotto.

Dark cassis, cedar, and spice are balanced by structured tannins, making it a perfect match for steak, braised meats, or roasted vegetables.

Bright cherry, subtle spice, and supple texture pair wonderfully with pasta, roasted poultry, or pizza.

France – Gamay Noir

Produced by a family-owned domaine in the northern Beaujolais Villages, Clos de Vieux Bourg emphasizes old-vine Gamay fruit, traditional vinification, and gentle maceration to highlight purity and freshness. Bright red berries, floral notes, and subtle spice make it perfect for charcuterie, roasted poultry, or vegetable dishes.

From South Australia's Riverland, Oxford Landing combines sustainable vineyard practices with precise, modern winemaking to produce a Chardonnay that expresses the region's warmth and soil diversity. Fresh pear, apple, and citrus notes are lifted by a hint of creaminess, making it an ideal partner for seafood, roasted chicken, or creamy pasta.



Bordeaux – Red Blend
Chateau Fleur Saint Bonnet Medoc 2023

Nestled in the Médoc's Left Bank, Château Fleur Saint Bonnet draws from gravelly soils planted to Cabernet Sauvignon and Merlot, producing a wine that reflects classic Bordeaux structure and elegance while showing careful handling in both barrel and bottle aging. Cassis, plum, and spice combine with smooth tannins, pairing wonderfully with roast lamb, beef, or hard cheeses.
