The Vocoret family has been producing Chablis for four generations, sourcing fruit from classic Kimmeridgian limestone slopes that give the wines their hallmark minerality and tension. Fermented in stainless steel to preserve purity, this Chablis offers crisp apple, lemon, and oyster shell notes — an ideal match for oysters, grilled white fish, or creamy pasta with seafood.


