Argentina – Malbec
**Altos Las Hormigas
Malbec Terroir 2024**

Altos Las Hormigas is a benchmark Mendoza producer known for shifting Malbec away from heavy oak toward vineyard expression, particularly limestone and alluvial soils. Fermented in concrete and aged with restraint, this wine prioritizes balance and structure over sheer power. Dark berry fruit, violet, and mineral tension give it a fresh, food-friendly profile suited to grilled meats.

California – Zinfandel
Ridge Lytton Springs 2023

“Blending 76% Zinfandel, 14% Petite Sirah, 7% Carignane, 2% Alicante Bouschet and 1% Mataro from an estate vineyard in Dry Creek Valley purchased in 1972, the 2023 Zinfandel Lytton Springs exhibits initial chewiness that leads to fine tannins, with a good heft and underlying acidity. Well-woven oak supports a moderately ripe, medium-bodied frame of structured elegance, aged in 100% air-dried American oak.”

This small Pomerol estate farms 100% old-vine Merlot on gravel and clay soils near some of the appellation’s most prestigious neighbors. Production is limited, and the focus is on concentration and age-worthiness. Deep color, rich dark fruit (cherry, blackberry), violet, spice, and chocolate notes, with a velvety texture, firm tannins, and excellent balance, showing impressive complexity and aging potential.

From one of Oregon’s founding wineries, Ponzi Tavola blends estate fruit with select Willamette Valley partner vineyards, made using the same gravity-flow winery and gentle techniques as their higher-end cuvées. Bright cherry, cranberry, and baking spice lead into a silky, medium-bodied palate with fresh acidity, making it an ideal, food-friendly Pinot for poultry, salmon, or mushroom dishes.

Domaine Jomain is a family-run estate in Burgundy’s Côte d’Or that crafts elegant, terroir-driven wines from limestone-rich vineyards in Meursault and the surrounding communes. This Bourgogne Blanc offers crisp lemon, green apple, and white peach framed by chalky mineral tension and bright acidity. Clean and balanced, it pairs beautifully with oysters, grilled fish, or creamy pasta dishes.

Produced by the team behind Château Angélu, this Bordeaux blend highlights Merlot from a powerful, structured vintage. The winemaking emphasizes richness and polish while maintaining balance. Dark plum, cocoa, and fine tannins give it depth without heaviness.

Tenuta Buon Tempo is an organic estate in southern Montalcino focused on transparent, site-driven Sangiovese. The Rosso is made for earlier drinking while retaining Brunello-like structure. Red cherry, wild herbs, and fresh acidity give it authenticity and balance.

From high-altitude vineyards in central Spain, Vega Moragona champions old-vine Bobal grown in dry continental conditions. The goal is to showcase the variety's structure and savory depth rather than rusticity. Dark berries, spice, and firm tannins make it well-suited to hearty dishes.

Lamblin is best known for its Chablis holdings, and that cool-climate precision carries into this Bourgogne Blanc.

Fruit comes from limestone soils that emphasize freshness and minerality. Citrus, green apple, and subtle almond notes give it a clean, focused profile.
