**Super Tuscan Blend**

Le Macchiole is a trailblazing Bolgheri estate known for elevating Super Tuscan blends with precision and elegance. Their Bolgheri Rosso reflects coastal Tuscany's sun-drenched fruit balanced by meticulous cellar work. Plush blackberry and spice notes complement grilled steak, pasta Bolognese, or aged pecorino.

Chardonnay - Burgundy

Louis Jadot, established in 1859, is one of Burgundy's most historic négociants with extensive estate holdings. Clos de Malte reflects Santenay terroir through classic Burgundian élevage and restrained oak use. Very fresh nose of lemon and acacia blossom with notes of fresh almonds, vanilla and garden herbs. A delightful example of this underrated white wine appellation that combines zesty freshness with an elegant medium body. Long lemony and slightly salty finish.

Marqués de Cáceres modernized Rioja in the 1970s by introducing French oak techniques while preserving traditional Tempranillo structure. The Vendimia Seleccionada bottling highlights specially selected fruit aged to Reserva standards for added depth. Cherry, cedar, and baking spice flavors pair beautifully with lamb, tapas, or Manchego.

Founded in 1946, E. Guigal is one of the Rhône Valley's benchmark producers, sourcing from multiple vineyard sites for consistency and quality. Their Côtes du Rhône blends Syrah, Grenache, and Mourvèdre for classic regional character. Ripe red berries and peppery spice make it excellent with roasted chicken or Mediterranean fare.

Château Bourdieu is a family-owned Right Bank estate producing approachable Merlot-driven Bordeaux blends. Traditional vinification and moderate oak aging keep the style balanced and accessible. Red currant and soft spice notes pair nicely with roast chicken or charcuterie.

Lingua Franca was founded in Oregon's Eola-Amity Hills with Burgundian influence from Dominique Lafon and a mission to highlight volcanic soils through biodynamic farming and precision winemaking. "Tongue 'n Cheek" is a flagship blend of estate and carefully selected vineyard parcels, crafted with native fermentations and thoughtful oak aging to emphasize structure and site transparency. Silky red cherry, raspberry, rose petal, and forest floor notes make it a beautiful pairing for duck, mushroom dishes, cedar-planked salmon, or herb-roasted poultry.

Cabernet Sauvignon - Washington  
**Sleight of Hand Illusionist Reserve Cabernet Sauvignon 2021**  
**\$44.99 – save \$22.**

Sleight of Hand Cellars combines rock-and-roll spirit with serious Walla Walla wine-making, sourcing top Columbia Valley fruit. The Illusionist Reserve represents a barrel selection aged for added depth and polish. Dark cassis, mocha, and structured tannins pair perfectly with rib-eye, lamb, or aged cheeses.

Syrah - Washington  
**K Vintners Klein Syrah 2019**  
**\$19.99 – save \$55.**

“Darker fruits, black olive tapenade, pepper, and ample leafy herb notes all emerge from the 2019 Syrah Klein Vineyard, a big, smoky, meaty, tannic, and full-bodied Syrah. Coming from a single vineyard located on the western side of the Walla Walla Valley, it will benefit from just a year or two of bottle age and keep for over a decade”

Sauvignon Blanc - Washington  
**Avennia Olianne Sauvignon Blanc 2023**

Avennia, founded by Chris Peterson and Marty Taucher, focuses on site-specific Washington wines with balance and restraint. The Olianne Sauvignon Blanc emphasizes freshness and mineral clarity over overt ripeness. Citrus zest, green apple, and herbal lift make it perfect for oysters, goat cheese, or fresh salads.



Chardonnay - Washington  
**Mark Ryan Monkey Wrench Quintessence Vineyard Chardonnay 2023**  
**\$19.99 – save \$18.**

Mark Ryan Winery was founded in Walla Walla and is known for bold Washington reds, but Monkey Wrench highlights the team's ability to craft focused, vineyard-driven whites. Quintessence Vineyard fruit brings structure and precision, with careful oak integration to preserve site expression. Bright orchard fruit, citrus, and subtle toast make this a great match for roast chicken, halibut, or creamy pasta dishes. Previously only sold to restaurants.



Cabernet Franc - Washington  
**Woodward Canyon Estate Cabernet Franc 2021**  
**\$34.99 – save \$20.**

Founded in 1981, Woodward Canyon is one of Washington's pioneering wineries with a long commitment to estate-driven wines. Their Cabernet Franc showcases careful vineyard management and balanced oak aging to highlight varietal character. Red plum, peppercorn, and savory herbs make it a natural with pork tenderloin or roasted vegetables.

Cabernet Sauvignon - Washington  
**Walla Walla Vintners CV**



**Cabernet Sauvignon 2022**  
**\$19.99 – save \$17.**

Since 1995, Walla Walla Vintners has focused on balanced, site-expressive wines from Washington's premier AVA. The CV Cabernet highlights varietal purity with thoughtful oak aging for structure. Ripe blackberry and cassis flavors stand up beautifully to grilled steak or barbecue.

**Mira Salinas Monastrell 2020**

Mira Salinas showcases Spain's Jumilla region, where old-vine Monastrell thrives in arid Mediterranean conditions. "...sports a vivid purple hue and offers remarkable purity in its crème de cassis, crushed violets, spice box, crushed stone, and graphite nuances. It's concentrated, medium to full-bodied, has remarkable purity, and ripe tannins."

Marino Abate works with Sicilian growers to highlight indigenous varieties shaped by Mediterranean warmth. Nero d'Avola is Sicily's flagship grape, known for bold fruit and supple tannins.

Ripe black cherry and spice pair beautifully with grilled sausage or tomato-based pasta.

Pinot Noir - France  
**Nuiton-Beaunoy**  
**Bourgogne Rouge 2023**

Nuiton-Beaunoy sources Pinot Noir from across Burgundy to craft accessible, terroir-driven regional wines. Traditional Burgundian methods preserve freshness and elegance in a classic style. Bright red cherry and subtle earthiness complement roast poultry or soft cheeses.

Marisco Vineyards farms sustainably in Marlborough, New Zealand, focusing on vibrant aromatics and purity of fruit. The NED Pinot Gris reflects the region's cool climate and bright natural acidity. Pear, citrus, and floral notes are perfect with seafood, sushi, or light appetizers.

Louis Merle farms Premier Cru vineyards in Chablis with an emphasis on expressing Kimmeridgian limestone soils. Vaillon is known for combining structure, tension, and classic mineral purity. Lemon zest and flinty minerality pair wonderfully with oysters or white fish.

Sagemoor Estate is one of Washington's historic vineyard properties, supplying fruit to many of the state's top producers. This estate white blend reflects careful farming and balance-driven winemaking. Citrus and stone fruit flavors make it an easy pairing with seafood or fresh salads.
