Sourced from the cool Oak Knoll District of Napa Valley, this Chardonnay showcases Muir-Hanna Vineyard's long reputation for producing vibrant, balanced fruit, with careful barrel aging adding texture without overwhelming the vineyard character. Crafted in a restrained style, it highlights freshness and site expression rather than excessive richness. Layers of citrus, pear, baked apple and subtle hazelnut lead to a creamy finish, making it an excellent partner for roast chicken, halibut, lobster or mushroom risotto.

From Australia's Yarra Valley, Thousand Candles farms a diverse, biodynamically inspired estate where whole-cluster fermentation and gentle winemaking create Pinot Noir of elegance and



complexity. The 2021 vintage earned 95 points from Halliday Wine Companion, reflecting the exceptional growing season and the wine's purity and finesse. Bright cherry, raspberry and baking spice flavors are framed by silky tannins, making it a beautiful match for duck, grilled salmon or wild mushroom dishes.

The Brotte family has been producing Rhône Valley wines since 1931, combining generations of experience with sustainably farmed vineyards throughout the region. Their Crozes-Hermitage showcases Syrah grown on granite and alluvial soils that emphasize freshness and aromatic lift. Blackberry, violet and black pepper flavors make this a natural match for grilled lamb, steak, duck or hearty stews.

remarkable precision. Al Passo blends Sangiovese with international varieties, offering both Tuscan character and generous accessibility. Ripe black cherry, plum and spice flavors make it an outstanding companion to grilled meats, pasta with ragù or aged cheeses.

Italy - Gropello Rose

Produced on the southwestern shores of Lake Garda, Ca' Maiol's Roseri is made primarily from Gropello, the signature grape of Valtènesi, creating one of Italy's most distinctive dry rosés.

The lake's moderating influence preserves freshness while allowing the fruit to develop delicate aromatics and vibrant acidity. Fresh strawberry, watermelon and citrus notes make this an ideal pairing for grilled seafood, salads, charcuterie or warm summer evenings.

From 60-year-old, south-facing Gamay vines in the Terre de Thé vineyard, where pink granite soils and the prestigious Moulin-à-Vent cru produce some of Beaujolais' most structured and age-worthy wines.



BIG SAVINGS

About two-thirds of the fruit is fermented as whole clusters with partial carbonic maceration to enhance aromatics and texture, while a portion of the wine is aged in French oak to add complexity without overshadowing the vineyard's character. The wine offers vibrant cherry, raspberry, plum, floral notes, cracked pepper, and wet stone minerality with fine tannins, making it an excellent partner for roast chicken, grilled pork, duck, mushroom dishes, or charcuterie, and it will continue to develop gracefully over the next 5–8 years.

climate, producing wines that combine bright fruit with peppery spice and lively acidity. Blackberry, black cherry and cracked pepper notes make this an outstanding companion to smoked sausages, barbecue, roasted pork or grilled vegetables.

Washington - Red Blend

JB Neufeld blends fruit from premier Washington vineyards to create wines that emphasize balance, concentration and the distinctive character of the Columbia Valley. Careful oak aging integrates richness while allowing the fruit to remain the focus. Dark berry, cocoa and spice flavors make this a versatile match for

grilled steaks, barbecue, braised short ribs or aged cheddar.

WHITE

Washington - White Blend

Inspired by the great white wines of Châteauneuf-du-Pape, Tranche blends Rhône varieties grown in Washington State to capture richness while maintaining freshness. Careful barrel fermentation and lees aging contribute texture and complexity without sacrificing vibrant fruit. Citrus, stone fruit and floral notes with a hint of spice pair wonderfully with roasted chicken, seafood in cream sauces or grilled vegetables.

Grapefruit, passionfruit and fresh herbs make it an ideal pairing for oysters, goat cheese, salads or fresh seafood.

One of Oregon's pioneering wineries, Sokol Blosser has championed sustainable farming in the Dundee Hills for more than five decades. Their Pinot Gris is crafted to highlight bright fruit, lively acidity and the freshness that defines Oregon's cool climate. Pear, melon and citrus flavors pair wonderfully with seafood, salads, Asian cuisine or roasted turkey.



France - Aligote

The Jomain family has been crafting wines in Burgundy for generations, producing Aligoté that showcases the grape's vibrant acidity and limestone-driven minerality. Fermented primarily in stainless steel, it emphasizes freshness, precision and food-friendly balance. Crisp lemon, green apple and white flower notes make it a perfect match for oysters, fried fish, goat

RED

France - Pinot Noir

The Chardigny family farms sustainably in Burgundy, producing Pinot Noir that emphasizes finesse, purity and a true sense of place. Fruit is handled gently to preserve fresh aromatics while allowing the region's limestone soils to shine through. Red cherry, cranberry and subtle earthiness pair beautifully with roast chicken, pork tenderloin or mushroom dishes.



RED

This family-owned Cru Bourgeois estate in the Haut-Médoc benefited from a long period of bottle aging, allowing the wine to develop the complexity that makes mature Bordeaux so rewarding. The classic Cabernet Sauvignon-based blend balances structure with elegance after more than a decade in cellar. Notes of blackcurrant, cedar, tobacco and earthy spice pair beautifully with roast lamb, beef tenderloin or hard cheeses.

Sourced from old vineyards in Bierzo's famed "Golden Mile," where the region's slate and clay soils and cool mountain influences produce some of Spain's most expressive Mencía. Hand-harvested fruit is fermented in stainless steel before spending 10 months in French and American oak, adding depth and spice while preserving the variety's vibrant character. The wine layers blackberry, raspberry, violets, herbs, espresso, and dark chocolate over silky tannins, making it an outstanding match for grilled lamb, roasted pork, mushroom dishes, or Spanish tapas.
