Land of Saints, Sauvignon Blanc

Santa Barbara, California

This refreshing and bright Sauvignon Blanc, sourced from vineyards in Los Olivos District and San Lucas in Santa Barbara County, is a great example of new world Sauvignon Blanc. Textured and elegant, with notes of ripe citrus, mango, peach blossom, chamomile and sage, this is an easygoing sipper for every day and any occasion.

Chateau St. Michelle, Chardonnay Indian Wells

Columbia Valley, Washington

The nose is inviting and rich, offering a burst of ripe tropical fruits, especially prominent notes of pineapple and mango. Additionally, the nose includes creamy butterscotch, vanilla, and a subtle hint of toasted oak along with baking spices. The palate is full-bodied, soft, and rich, delivering a luscious note of ripe pineapple, yellow apple, and pear, balanced by the richness of butter and caramel. The wine

maintains a good acidic balance, providing freshness and a smooth finish with a touch of minerality.

Trouillet Lebeau Condemines Chardonnay

Saint-Véran, Burgundy, France

This wine comes from 70-year-old vines that are ideally located on a south-facing slope in the village of Leynes, on a clay-limestone terroir. Aged 100% in Burgundy barrels, offering a fruity, powerful and charming wine. Beautiful expressive aromas of ripe yellow fruits. Rich, generous, full, crisp and well-balanced on the palate. Ideally situated at the foot of the famous rock of Solutré, in the hamlet of Pouilly, is Les Vins Trouillet Lebeau.

Maison Shaps, Saint-Romain Blanc

Burgundy, France

"Sous le Château" is located on the steep hillsides of Saint-Romain. The soil consists of heavy limestone. This south-facing, limestone site situated on a steep incline has ideal conditions for ripening and drainage. Sous le Château is one of the top village sites in Saint-Romain, which creates wines with intense minerality, lime, pear, and apple notes. This is a very elegant style of chardonnay, with a judicious amount of oak that promotes an elegance without overpowering the grape, and adds to a lengthy finish.

Chateau St. Michelle, Cabernet Sauvignon

Cold Creek, Columbia Valley, Washington
The 2021 season produced red wines dark in color and dense in concentration. The Indian Wells Cabernet is our warm climate ripe, jammy 'New World' style of Cabernet Sauvignon. This premier Cabernet Sauvignon showcases a lush texture and

concentrated flavors of blackberry and black cherry. This wine is full and the finish is brilliant. WE91 VS91

Château de Saint Cosme, Côtes du Rhône
France

Cassis, violet and blackberry flavors are round and supple on the palate in this dark red, with charred cedar, smoked meat and pepper adding depth and range. A densely structured version. They have reverted to the intrinsic character of my first Côtes du Rhône from 1997 to 2000. This intense, energetic Syrah with its crimson hue is fresh with 'espressivo cantabile' aromas of red berry fruits and a rounded palate.

Pavillon du Glana, Saint-Julien
Bordeaux, France

The 2019 vintage at this estate is once again in line with some of the greatest. Even though the vines experienced significant water stress, this did not halt ripening. Wines from this vintage have a high alcohol content, but nevertheless present an impressive fruitiness and a beautiful tannic structure, resulting in a well-balanced blend thanks especially to the remarkable Cabernet Sauvignon. Chateau Le Boscq, Saint-Estephe
Bordeaux, France

Château Le Boscq is a fine wine from Saint-Estèphe, ideally situated next to the Gironde estuary. Beautiful deep color with purple hints. Rich and intense, the nose presents complex notes of black fruits, spices, licorice, and precious wood. Ample and full-bodied from the attack, the palate is fleshy and juicy, bursting with character. The long, velvety finish reflects the typical character of this beautiful Saint-Estèphe terroir, balancing richness and elegance. WE94 DC95 JD92

Château Saint-Pierre, Pomerol
Bordeaux, France

Expressive on the nose; very aromatic. The palate is delicious - dense and structured, powerful and muscular but so well packaged. Uber glamour here. Real depth of flavor with lingering spice from the liquorice and sweet cedar, some bitter dark chocolate, floral touches and even soft savory truffle aspects too. The texture is chewy with balancing intensity with freshness and

such clarity that you know it's been well made. DC95 JS93

Château Clos de Bouïard
G de Clos de Bouïard

Montagne Saint-Émilion, Bordeaux, France
Deep ruby red. Composed of Merlot, Cabernet Franc and Cabernet Sauvignon, offers an eye-fluttering bouquet of juicy, red berry fruits tinged with spice. The medium-bodied palate is loaded with ripe strawberry, black raspberry, and mulberry accented with baking spice and a hint of crushed limestone. Those lush fruits are enveloped by seductively smooth tannins which gently guide this wine toward a long, elegant finish.

Château Haut-Bruly

Saint-Émilion, Bordeaux, France
Chateau Haut Bruly Saint-Emilion Grand Cru is a full-bodied red wine from the Bordeaux region of France. It has a deep ruby color and aromas of ripe blackberry, cassis, and dark cherry. On the palate, it has a velvety texture with flavors of blackberry, dark chocolate, and a hint of spice. The tannins are well-integrated and the finish is long and lingering. DC91 WE91

Château de Pressar

Saint Emilion, Bordeaux, France
The 2020 de Pressac is a wine of real charm and seduction. Bright floral and citrus notes drive a core of sweet red cherry fruit. Chalk, mint, white pepper, smoke and dried herbs lend notable aromatic complexity. As always, the blend includes Cabernet Franc plus drops of Malbec and Carmenere, which lends quite a bit of nuance. The 2020 is an especially elegant Pressac. In my view, Pressac remains one of the most criminally underrated wines in all of Saint Emilion. On the other hand, that makes it a screaming value.

Chateau Grand Mayne, Grand Cru Classé
Saint-Emilion 2018, Bordeaux, France

Deep ruby hue is followed by a medium to full-bodied, nicely concentrated Saint-Emilion with notable chalky minerality, loads of sumptuous blackberry fruits, notes of chocolate and leafy herbs, firm, present, yet ripe tannins, and a great finish. It shows a more backward, reserved side to the vintage, yet I love its purity of fruit, its balance, and its overall class.

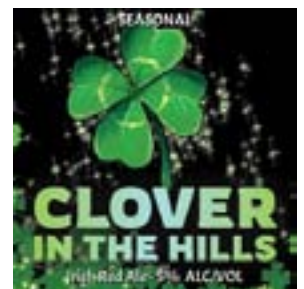
